INSTRUCTIONS: Keep this page and bring it to the event.

ARRIVAL: Please follow these steps:

1. Check in at the Registration Tent at the Trombley House
2. Complete a Registration Form if you have not already done so.
3. Sign your Liability Waiver form and obtain your parking pass.
4. Check in with your Camp Commander for your correct campsite.

NOTICE: There are changes this year that require camp boundary realignments. If necessary, we will ask you to move if you set up in the wrong location.

CAMPING: Only period appropriate within the encampment. RV hookups and modern tents are not allowed. For modern camping options, check on-line for campgrounds near Bay City, Michigan.

SETUP TIMES: For safety and insurance reasons, please respect setup times as follows:

DAY	SETUP and ACCESS TIMES
THUR – 21 st	NO Setup before NOON – No vehicles in camp overnight please.
FRI – 22 nd	NO VEHICLES IN CAMP from 8 AM until 3 PM – School children present. This will be strictly enforced for safety and insurance reasons.
SAT – 23 rd	NO VEHICLES AFTER 8 AM (all day)
SUN – 24 th	Takedown AFTER 4 PM – No vehicles in camp PRIOR to 4 PM

SPACING: To meet local fire codes, space between the tents MUST be a minimum of 18 feet. The public should not be allowed access within 10 feet of a cooking fire. Use some sort of barrier to mark off fire areas.

PARKING: You may park along the east side of S Arbor Street, at the Community Center parking lot located at 800 John F. Kennedy Drive (west of Trombley House) or further north at the baseball field lots. Display your parking pass on the dashboard please.

After set-up, your vehicle MUST BE MOVED out of the encampment area and remain out during the event. If unfamiliar with the options, check with the Registration Tent for parking information.
